Not Feeling Great?

As we enter the height of the cold and flu season, we would like to remind you of our policy regarding medications that students may need, found on page 71 of the **Parent-Student Handbook**. In part the policy reads:

"All student medications must be submitted to the school office in their original containers, with parent explanation and permission for its administration. Medications are administered by the office staff. Emergency medications may be kept in a student's possession, with parent permission, office approval, and teacher knowledge. Non-prescription Tylenol is available in the school office and may be given by the office staff to a student when it is needed, with parent permission..."
