Continuous Enrollment

We look forward to having your family back on campus next year! Your child (ren) is/are automatically enrolled for the 2021-2022 school year and every year following unless you tell us otherwise. This process makes re-enrollment easy for you. Tuition Assistance Application Process

The FAST Tuition Assistance online application process for school year 2021-2022 is open. It's to your advantage to be included in the March round of consideration, so please complete your application as soon as possible.



The deadline for completing the FAST online application for this first round is Wednesday, March 3, and the deadline for submitting

all supporting documentation to FAST is Monday, March 15. Types of documentation requested include, but are not limited to, your most recent federal and state tax returns and W-2s. IMPORTANT REMINDER!

Staff or students who are exhibiting signs or symptoms of any viral infection should stay home and not come on school grounds. Staff and students should be fever free, without the use of any medications, for 48 hours before coming on school grounds. If symptoms of infection continue for 48 hours or more, staff and students should seek medical advice. Staff or students who test positive for COVID-19, or who have a family member living with them who tests positive for COVID-19, should quarantine until they are cleared by a medical professional.
