Bussing Requirement

Parents: When you receive report cards on March 19, there will be a transportation insert for the 2019-2020 school year. This form MUST be filled out and



returned to the office if you want your student to use a bus next year. Just because you signed up for bussing this year does NOT mean you will be registered for next year. The state is requiring that a form be completed every year for each student in order to ride a bus. Direct any questions you may have to Mrs. Gardner as soon as possible.

Re-enrollment Facts

Do you know that your **student(s) will** automatically be re-enrolled for the upcoming school year? No action is required on your part if students will continue their enrollment at CCS! We are asking that families contact the school office by April 1 if they are not returning to CCS next year. Families that inform the office by April 1 will not incur a Transfer of Records Fee of \$150 per student. To be fully informed, read the entire re-enrollment letter that is again attached to the newsletter email.

CCS "March Madness"

Dress Code Changes

As of the third trimester several changes are in effect for the school appearance code. Mr.

Parris sent out this information to families in mid-January, and a copy of that letter is being sent with the

newsletter email this week. With respect to wearing shorts, either for PE or for class (April through June), the minimum inseam length for shorts for all ages is 5 inches. Additional guidelines are in place for those playing sports. In addition, the Board of Trustees believes now is the appropriate time to remove the restriction on wearing camouflage to school.

Remember that the CCS Appearance Code is in effect for students any time that they are on the school campus (not just during school hours) and at school-sponsored events off-campus.
